

**Eligibility guidelines:**

1. The competition is open only for the incoming first year students of the 17 TAS campuses (list mentioned below).
2. The student must have a total work experience of less than 72 months as of the time of joining the TAS Campus.
3. Students who have received a final admit from the flagship programs of the below mentioned TAS campuses are eligible to take part in the competition.
4. Students who are currently on the waitlist for the flagship programs of the TAS campuses are also eligible to participate in the first round of the competition. However, their participation in, or advancement to, further rounds shall be contingent on their final admission to the flagship programs of the TAS campuses.
5. It is an individual participation competition.
6. The TAS Office reserves the right to disqualify any participant upon the violation of any rule at any stage of the competition.

**TAS Interview Round Guidelines:**

1. The interview round participant must have a final offer or waitlist confirmation from one of the aforementioned TAS campuses.
2. The interview round participant should have successfully completed the undergraduate or post-graduate program if any (with no pending backlogs / exams / projects / submissions) at the time of joining the TAS batch.
3. The interview round participant should have a First-Class grade (60% or equivalent) in undergraduate, as well as in the post-graduate program (if any), if joining the TAS program.
4. In case a student does not finally join one of the eligible TAS campuses, the PPSI/PPSO (Pre-Placement Summer Interview/Offer) will be null and void.
5. All final decisions regarding eligibility will be taken by the TAS Office and their decision shall be binding.
